Teacher's Update:

Last week was a perfect week for letter "C", with the continuing construction happening on our new sanctuary, and lots of Christmas activities! We were very excited to see the walls go up on Friday and can't wait to see what happens next. Our classroom is beginning to look very festive with all of the decorations the students have been making, and we have been listening to the Christmas story as we prepare for our program, which is just over a week away!

There is a sign-up sheet in the hallway for each class for some items we will need to make sugar cone Christmas trees at our parties next week. Thank you to those who have already signed up, or even brought in items already. There are still some items needed, if you'd like to donate something.

Our class raffle projects will be on display this week. Thank you to Melanie in the morning class and Carissa in the afternoon class for taking on the projects! They both turned out super cute, and I'm excited for you to see them.

What we did last week:

During Carpet (large group) time, we met our letter puppet, Coco C. Cookie, who taught us the sounds of letter "C", and enjoyed viewing the items that Caleb, Ella, Charlie, and Liv brought back in the letter bag to show us. We read our Alphatales book Copycats by Maria Fleming, Bear Stays up for Christmas by Karma Wilson, Room for a Little One by Martin Waddell, and Mortimer's Christmas Manger by Karma Wilson. We played a "what's missing" game with our mouse puppet, Mortimer; he showed us the items in his stocking and we tried to guess which item was missing when he took one away. Everyone was really good at this game! We also learned our Bible verse for December, and our new color, number, and shape, and practiced for our Christmas program.

During Center (small group) time, we learned to make letter "C" using one big or little curve with play dough, wood pieces, and tracing and writing the letter, and made our own Coco C. Cookie puppets. We used hole punches and tissue paper to make the cute trees on our hallway bulletin board, made ornaments and paper chains to hang on our classroom Christmas trees, and dot-painted presents for our classroom board. We cut, colored, and glued to make pretty gingerbread house pictures, and had fun making magnetic sensory bottles, playing with new green playdough with Christmas cutters and colorful beads, and playing with our classroom Nativity set.
